

ORDINANCE NO. 11  
(Series 1983)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO, AMENDING CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM PERMIT REGULATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO, as follows:

Section 1.

Subsection 10.13-5(A) of the Lake City Municipal Code is amended to read, as follows:

10.13-5(A): Immediately upon approval of a permit for a system which is not installed, the company shall make application for all permits, licenses or approvals which might be required by any governmental entity or agency, including the Federal Communication Commission, and shall pursue such applications with due diligence. Within six months after approval of a permit for a system which is not installed or within six months after receipt of all necessary approvals from the FCC, whichever is later, the company shall commence significant construction of the system and shall complete system construction with due diligence thereafter.

Section 2.

Subsection 10.13-5(B) of the Lake City Municipal Code is amended to read, as follows:

10.13-5(B): Within fifteen (15) days after the approval of a permit for a system which is not installed, the company shall file with the Town a Corporate Surety Bond in a form acceptable to the Town in the amount of \$20,000, or shall deposit with the Town a Cash Bond in the amount of \$20,000, or shall provide an Irrevocable Letter of Credit for \$20,000 on a form acceptable to the Town, to guarantee the timely construction and full activation of the proposed cable system within two years of the date that the Board of Trustees grants the permit.

Section 3.

Subsection 4(B)(1) of Ordinance No. 3, Series 1983, is amended to read, as follows:

4(B)(1): Applications of the initial CATV Permit shall be accepted until November 15, 1983.

Section 4.

The Board of Trustees hereby finds that no applications for CATV Permits were submitted within the thirty (30) day period after the effective date of Ordinance No. 3, Series 1983, but that a formal application has now been submitted and at least one other company has evidenced an interest in submitting an application. The Board has determined that in order to allow additional applications and to process applications and issue a permit so that a CATV system can be installed as soon as possible, that an emergency exists and that it is necessary that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare.

INTRODUCED, READ and ADOPTED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake City, Colorado, by a unanimous vote this 2<sup>ND</sup> day of November, 1983.
