

ORDINANCE NO. 1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO, AMENDING FILING DEADLINES FOR WRITE-IN CANDIDATE AFFIDAVITS OF INTENT TO COMPLY WITH CHANGES IN STATE LAW AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO, as follows:

Section 1:

Subsection 3.1-5 of the Lake City Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

3.1-5: WRITE-IN AFFIDAVITS OF INTENT:


No write-in vote for any municipal office shall be counted at any election unless an Affidavit of Intent has been filed with the Town Clerk by the person whose name is written in twenty days before the day of the election indicating that such person desires the office and is qualified to assume the duties of that office if elected.

Section 2: EMERGENCY DECLARED:


The Board of Trustees hereby finds that this ordinance is necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare, and in order to be consistent with state law and apply at the coming municipal election, it must go into effect immediately upon adoption and therefore an emergency exists.

INTRODUCED, READ and ADOPTED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake City, Colorado, by a majority vote this 4th day of March, 1992.
