AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO
DEDICATING CERTAIN ALLEYWAYS AND OTHER PROPERTY OF THE
TOWN FOR PUBLIC USE AS PART OF A COUNTY PARK.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 10 dated April 6, 1994, the Board of Commissioners of Hinsdale County, Colorado dedicated certain lots in the Foot~~e~~ and Richardson Addition and in Wade's Addition, to the Town of Lake City, Colorado (commonly known as the County Yard) for public use as a park; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Lake City, Colorado, at the request of the Hinsdale County Commissioners, finds it to be in the public interest to make a supplemental dedication for such park purposes of certain land, including alleyways, now owned by the Town and located within and about the aforementioned lots dedicated by the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake City that the following described real property be and is hereby dedicated for public use as a public park:

All that part of Henson Street and the alleyways between Blocks 1 and 2 of the Foot~~e~~ and Richardson Addition to the Town of Lake City, Colorado, together with a strip of land running along the North lines of the following lots in said Foot~~e~~ and Richardson Addition: Lot 1, Block 1; Lot 1, Block 2; Lot 16, Block 2; Lot 1, Block 3; and Lot 32, Block 3. All of the subject dedicated property is more particularly identified by cross-hatching on the attached property location diagram marked Schedule A. Subject to all easements and rights of way for existing public utility lines and reserving unto the Town of Lake City the right to access and control public use of the area surrounding the Town's Water Well No. 3 within a distance of 250 feet thereof.
