

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO,  
ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE UNIFORM MECHANICAL CODE; AND  
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake  
City, Colorado, as follows:

Section 1: Adoption of Code: It is hereby adopted for the  
purpose of providing minimum standards to safeguard life, limb,  
health, property and public welfare, the Uniform Mechanical Code,  
1994 Edition, as published by the International Conference of  
Building Officials, 5360 South Workman Mill Road, Whittier,  
California, the subject matter of which includes regulation of  
the design, construction, quality of materials, erection,  
installation, alteration, repair, location, relocation,  
replacement, addition to, use or maintenance of heating,  
ventilating, cooling, refrigeration systems, incinerators or  
other miscellaneous heat-producing appliances in the Town of Lake  
City, Colorado and providing for the issuance of permits and  
collection of fees therefor.

Section 2: Penalties: Penalties applicable to violations of the  
aforementioned Uniform Mechanical Code, shall include a fine of  
not more than \$300.00 or a jail sentence of not more than 90  
days, or both, as determined by the Municipal Court of the Town  
of Lake City, Colorado. It shall be unlawful for any person,  
firm or corporation to commit any act or omission in violation of  
the aforementioned Uniform Mechanical Code.
