

ORDINANCE NO. 6
(Series 1997)

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO,
FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC, ADOPTING BY
REFERENCE A NEW SECTION 613 UNDER THE 1995 EDITION
OF THE "MODEL TRAFFIC CODE FOR COLORADO
MUNICIPALITIES", AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATION THEREOF.**

WHEREAS, the 1995 edition of the Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities has been previously adopted as Ordinance No. 2 (Series 1996) by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake City; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Trustees has determined that adoption of the recently promulgated Section 613 thereof would be in the best interests of the inhabitants of the Town of Lake City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake City, Colorado, as follows:

Section 1: Adoption. There is hereby adopted by reference Section 613 of the 1995 edition of the "Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities" promulgated and published as such by the Colorado Department of Transportation, Staff Traffic and Safety Projects Branch, 4201 East Arkansas Avenue, Denver, Colorado 80222. Said Section is entitled and essentially provides for "designation of highway maintenance, repair or construction zones - signs - increase in penalties for speeding violations" and contains three consecutively numbered subparagraphs. Three copies of the Model Traffic Code previously adopted, and to which Section 613 is hereby approved for addition, are now filed in the office of the Clerk of the Town of Lake City, Colorado, and may be inspected during regular business hours.

Section 2: Violation and Penalties. It is unlawful for any person to violate Section 613 of said Model Traffic Code. Every person convicted of a violation of any provision thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$300.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. The Municipal Court is expressly authorized to impose fines or other penalties for speeding in zones controlled by said Section 613 of the Model Traffic Code that are twice the amount of fines or other penalties ordinarily imposed for speeding in zones not controlled by said Section 613, subject, however, to the aforementioned maximums.

Section 3: Application. This ordinance shall apply to every street, alley, sidewalk area, driveway, park, and to every other public way or public place or public parking area, within or without the corporate limits of the Town of Lake City, Colorado the use of which the Town of Lake City has jurisdiction and authority to regulate.

Section 4: Validity and Severability. If any part or parts of this ordinance be for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or of any other prior ordinance on which this ordinance is dependent.
