

ORDINANCE NO. 3

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE FIRE PROTECTION REGULATIONS OF THE LAKE CITY MUNICIPAL CODE AND ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE NFPA 101 LIFE SAFETY CODE, 2000 EDITION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Subsection 15.6-1 of the Lake City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

15.6-1 Adoption of Codes

(A) There is hereby adopted for the purpose of providing minimum standards to prevent fires, protect persons and property and to promote the public health, safety and welfare, NFPA 101 Life Safety Code, 2000 Edition, which is published by the National Fire Protection Association, 1 Batterymarch Park, Quincy, MA 02269. The subject matter of the aforementioned code is comprehensive regulations for fire prevention and control, and safety in fire escape circumstances.

(B) One copy of the aforementioned codes is on file in the office of the Town Clerk and may be inspected during regular business hours. Additional copies are available for purchase.

SECTION 2:


The amendment of the Lake City Municipal Code established by this Ordinance shall not affect any offense or act committed, any penalty incurred, any contract, right, or duty established or accruing before the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3:


If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application of it to any person or circumstance, is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications. The provisions of this Ordinance are expressly declared to be severable.
