

ORDINANCE NO. 2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO, MODIFYING CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED BY C.R.S. 12-47-313 WITH REGARD TO THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE CURRENT LOCATION OF LAKE CITY HIGH SCHOOL AND THE BUSINESS KNOWN AS "TIC TOC DINER".

WHEREAS, C.R.S. 12-47-313 requires a minimum distance of 500 feet between school facilities and any establishment whose owners seek a liquor license; and

WHEREAS, said statute authorizes a Colorado municipality to reduce the aforementioned distance restriction in appropriate circumstances; and

WHEREAS, Jordan and Sonya Roberts, as owners of the "Tic Toc Diner" have applied for a license to serve alcoholic beverages at said diner as part of their restaurant business; and

WHEREAS, the Tic Toc Diner is located less than 500 feet from the present location of Lake City High School; and

WHEREAS, the school administration has no objection to the subject liquor license and, in any event, plans to relocate the high school more than 500 feet away from the Tic Toc Diner in the near future;

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake City, pursuant to C.R.S. 12-47-313(1)(d)(III), that the aforementioned distance restriction of 500 feet be, and is hereby, reduced by such distance as may be required to accommodate the liquor license application of Jordan and Sonya Roberts for purposes of their restaurant business at the Tic Toc Diner. This ordinance shall become effective immediately.
