

ORDINANCE NO. 7  
(Series 2004)

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12.1-13 OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY'S MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL BY UNDERAGE INDIVIDUALS.**

WHEREAS, Colorado law presently sets the minimum age for legal purchase, possession or consumption of alcohol by any individual at twenty-one (21) years; and

WHEREAS, Lake City's Municipal Code Section 12.1-13 sets a lower age for the legal possession, use or consumption of certain alcoholic beverages by individuals, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Lake City desire to conform the Town's Code provisions regarding the minimum age for legal alcohol use with the overriding provisions of state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake City, Colorado as follows:


1. Paragraphs 4 and 5 of Section 12.1-13 of the Lake City Municipal Code are hereby repealed. Paragraph 4 thereof is hereby reenacted to provide and make it illegal:


"For any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to possess, purchase or consume any type of alcoholic beverage within the limits of the Town of Lake City, Colorado. Illegal possession, purchase or consumption of such alcoholic beverages by an underage person is a strict liability offense."

2. As amended in the preceding paragraph 1, Section 12.1-13 of the Lake City Municipal Code is otherwise fully ratified and confirmed.
