AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO, REPEALING AND REENACTING SUBSECTIONS 15.6-1 THROUGH 15.6-3 OF THE LAKE CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TO ADOPT BY REFERENCE THE 2006 INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE, THE NFPA 101 LIFE SAFETY CODE, THE NFPA 30 FLAMMABLE AND COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS CODE, THE NFPA 30A CODE FOR MOTOR FUEL DISPENSING FACILITIES AND REPAIR GARAGES AND THE NFPA 58 LIQUIFIED PETROLEUM GAS CODE; AND TO PROVIDE FOR REVISED REGULATIONS RELATING TO SUCH CODES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1:

Subsections 15.6-1 through 15.6-3 of the Lake City Municipal Code are hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

15.6-1 Adoption of Codes:

(A) There is hereby adopted, for the purpose of providing minimum standards to safeguard life, limb, health, property and public welfare, the 2006 Edition of the International Fire Code, as published by the International Code Council, 4051 W. Flossmoor Road, Country Club Hills, IL 60478-5795; and also the NFPA 101 Life Safety Code, the NFPA 30 Flammable and Combustible Liquids Code and NFPA 30A Code for Motor Fuel Dispensing Facilities and Repair Garages and the NFPA 58 Liquified Petroleum Gas Code, each as is respectively adopted and published by the National Fire Protection Association in the years 2003 - 2006. The subject matter of all of said Codes is comprehensive regulation for the prevention and containment of fire, explosions and dangerous fumes and vapors and for the general protection of life, health and property. Said Codes also provide for the issuance of related permits and collection of related fees.

(B) One complete copy of each of the above referenced Codes are on file in the office of the Town Clerk and may be inspected during regular business hours. Additional copies are available for purchase.

15.6-2 General Provisions:

(A) The provisions of this Section 6 and the Codes adopted by reference herein may be administered by all Town law enforcement officials, by the Chief of the Lake City Fire Protection District and by other Town officials authorized by the Board of Town Trustees.

(B) Whenever the word "jurisdiction" is used in any of the referenced Codes, it shall mean the Town of Lake City, Colorado.

(C) If there is any conflict of any provision of this Section 6 or any of the Codes adopted by reference herein with any other provision of any ordinance of the Town or other State or Federal Regulations, those regulations providing the more stringent or strict requirements shall apply.

15.6-3 Amendments and Modifications to Codes:

(A) The adoption of the International Fire Code referenced in Lake City Municipal Code Subsection 15.6-1 shall include Appendix B thereof, but shall omit Section 806.1.1, Occupancy A thereof.

(B) All other appendices and supplements of all of the Codes referenced in Lake City Municipal Code Subsection 15.6-1 shall be deemed included.

SECTION 2:

If any provision of this ordinance or the application of it to any person or circumstance is held invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can given effect without the invalid provisions or applications. The provisions of this ordinance are expressly declared to be severable.

SECTION 3:

The repeal and reenactment of various provisions of the Lake City Municipal Code in this ordinance shall not affect any offense or act committed, any penalty incurred, any contract, right, or duty established or accruing before the effective date of this ordinance.
