

Special Rec Trips

June 2,3,4 Sand Dunes Camping Trip Leave Friday at noon and visit dunes, overnight Friday, Hooper Pool and dunes Saturday, overnight Saturday, Drive back Sunday by lunch. Child pays entrance to pool and at least 2 meals. \$5 bus fee. (Maybe \$35 total)

June 25 and 26 Bear Creek Trail to Ouray Bear Creek Trail starts at the top of Engineer Pass and ends just outside of Ouray. It is a long hard downhill. All of it is downhill, approximately a 6000 foot elevation loss. We will have the bus waiting in Ouray at the hotel to pick you up. It requires a one night stay in Ouray and we will return around lunchtime on Monday. Adults must provide their own lodging in Ouray. We will try to find enough vehicles to get hikers to the top of Engineer Pass but we are not promising anything. It is your responsibility to make arrangements. It is a beautiful hike and if I remember it is about 9 miles. I have a limit of 12 hikers for the bus. Please register far in advance if you are interested.

The schedule is set up so Tuesday through Friday parents could send their children to activities from 10am – 3pm. Typically, this is for the 1st through 6th grade age group. This is not a day camp. We tried to simulate a day camp to make it easier for the parents but we don't have the staff to supervise the kids to make sure they are at every activity, this is the parent's responsibility. Your children can still come and go. If they are here all day for activities, you are welcome to send a lunch, they can keep it in the armory kitchen refrigerator.

We have tried to offer activities similar to the school sports offerings here in Lake City like volleyball, track, and basketball. Hopefully you will take advantage of the opportunity.

If your child will be attending a Public Health Day camp at the school and would like to attend one or more of the Rec programs that are concurrent with Public Health's, please communicate this so they can better plan their camp(s). If you need assistance getting the child from point A to point B between events, please let us know your need, we can try to work something out.

Occasionally, the regularly scheduled events might be cancelled due to special events held in the Armory. All Rec programming is cancelled on the 4th of July. August 17th will be the last day this brochure is in effect. We reserve the right to cancel any activity due to lack of attendance.
