

**TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO
ORDINANCE NO. 2014-4**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO,
AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 1, SERIES 1966, BY ADDING
A NEW CHAPTER 16 TO THE LAKE CITY MUNICIPAL CODE
CONCERNING PERMITS FOR PRIVATE USE OF PUBLIC
PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake City finds that the use of Town property by private parties should be subject to a reasonable permitting process; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees finds that this ordinance is necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, and promote the prosperity of the Town of Lake City and the inhabitants thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO, as follows:

Section 1:

Ordinance Number 1, Series 1966, is hereby amended by the addition of the following:

CHAPTER 16

PERMITS FOR USE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY

16.1 Permit Required for Private Use of Public Property. It shall be unlawful for any person, group, or organization to use any park, building, or other facility owned by the Town of Lake City, for a special event without first obtaining a permit issued by the Town.

16.2 Permit Applications. Application for a permit authorizing a person, group, or organization exclusive use of all or a portion of a Town owned park or facility for a special event, shall be made on a form prepared and made available by the Town and submitted to the Town Administrator no

less than thirty (30) days prior to the scheduled use of the park or facility. The Town Administrator may require any additional information from the applicant that is reasonably necessary to a fair determination as to whether a permit should issue.

16.3 Town Administrator to Grant Permits. The Town Administrator shall have the authority to establish criteria and grant special use permits for the temporary use or occupation of public property for special event. Any such permit shall be revocable in nature. If the Town Administrator denies a special use permit, the applicant shall have the right of appeal to the Board of Trustees.

16.4 Indemnification of Town. Whenever required as a condition to the issuance of a permit pursuant to this chapter, the applicant shall execute a written agreement to indemnify and hold harmless the Town, its officers and employees, from any loss, liability, damage or cost sustained by any person or property, to the extent any such loss, liability, damage or cost rises from any activity associated with the special event or use of Town owned equipment, supplies or property.

16.5 Definition. As used in this chapter, "special event" means a tournament, game, contest, party, or celebration, attended by ten (10) or more people.

Section 2:

This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day following publication, pursuant to COLO. REV. STAT. § 31-16-105.

Section 3:


The amendment of various provisions of the Town of Lake City Municipal Code Colorado by this ordinance shall not affect any offense or act committed, any penalty incurred, any contract, right, or duty established or accruing before the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 4:

If any provision of this ordinance or the application of it to any person or circumstance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or applications. The provisions of this ordinance are expressly declared to be severable.


